Health and Safety Representative Initial Occupational Health and Safety Training Course

5-Day course of training

The **HSR Initial OHS Training Course** is formally approved by WorkSafe Victoria for Health and Safety Representatives. Five days of intensive training provides participants with a comprehensive knowledge of rights and powers of HSRs and practical skills to assist in the implementation of those rights and powers. The course is conducted by OHS professionals currently involved in assisting workplaces to effectively implement health and safety programs.

The topics covered include:

Interpreting the OHS legislative framework and its relation to the HSR	Identifying key parties and their legislative obligations and duties
Establishing representation in the workplace	Participating in consultation & issue resolution
Representing designated work group members in any OHS risk management process undertaken by employers	Exercising the powers of a HSR under the OHS Act

Who would benefit from attending this course:

Health and Safety Representatives and Deputy Health and Safety Representatives. Although HSRs are the primary audience for this course, managers, supervisors and health and safety committee members will also benefit from attending this course.

Training entitlement:

An employer must if requested by a HSR (or deputy HSR) allow the HSR to attend a WorkSafe approved HSR Initial OHS Training Course after being elected and a HSR Refresher OHS Training Course at least once each year. The course to be attended by the HSR must be chosen by the HSR in consultation with their employer.

All our public training courses are conducted at the Amora Riverwalk Hotel Training Centre at 649 Bridge Road Richmond.

Participants are provided with lunch at the Amora Restaurant and free parking is available on site.
